





The Honorable Hushang Ansary

Hushang Ansary holds a distinguished record of service in private enterprise and the public domain. In his native Iran, he held important cabinet positions, including Minister of Economy and Minister of Finance and Economic Affairs, and was Iran's Ambassador to the United States. Mr. Ansary is one of Houston's most prominent philanthropists. His lifelong commitment to education, health care and the alleviation of human sufferings has been honored internationally. He has been decorated by the governments of Japan, South Korea, Norway and Pakistan. He is the recipient of numerous awards, including the Ellis Island Medal of Honor. Mr. Ansary is a founding member of the Baker Institute for Public Policy and has served on its Advisory Board since its inception.

The James A. Baker III Prize for Excellence in Leadership recognizes nationally and internationally renowned individuals for outstanding achievements in government, business, science, education or philanthropy. We award this prize to those who exemplify the vision of building "a bridge between the world of ideas and the world of action," conceived by the Honorable James A. Baker, III, when he established the Baker Institute. Recipients embody the institute's mission to nurture the ties between academia, government and the private sector.
