Call for Papers: 25th Annual Health Economics Conference October 16-17, 2014

The Health Policy Forum at Rice University's Baker Institute is pleased to host the **25th Annual Health Economics Conference (AHEC)** on Oct. 16-17, 2014.

We welcome submissions on a variety of health economics topics, including — but not limited to — the Affordable Care Act, controlling cost growth and provider incentives. Submissions from other areas of health economics are also welcome. The presentation format will be a short overview of the paper by the researcher and a presentation from a discussant, followed by audience discussion and feedback. AHEC is an invitation-only conference. Attendance is restricted to people actively participating as presenters or discussants.

Submit a Paper for Presentation

A panel of applied microeconomists will select 10 to 12 papers for presentation at AHEC, with a preference given to junior faculty; we also welcome submissions from doctoral students. Full papers are required in advance of the meeting. If you would like to present at AHEC, please submit a completed paper or an extended abstract (1 to 2 pages) by email to ahec2014@rice.edu no later than **5:00 p.m. CDT on Monday, May 12, 2014**.
